### **Sustainability Saturday Nights, *Tim Cordon***

*June 24* - EPC will take the lead in bringing the group Community Unity as a presenter. Community Unity is an art collective that believes that we are all artists and that by creating art together, we gain deeper understanding of who we are. By uniting through love, Ubuntu (the belief in a universal bond of sharing that connects all humanity) and the creative lens of art, Community Unity is helping neighbors to break down barriers and unite. They are helping to build relationships, community and connections that are helping others see the world in new and dynamic ways. Community Unity has collaborated with groups, like the Women of Worthington (WOW), the Brothers Aligned Coalition (BAC), The Goodman Community Center, The Lussier Community Center, Fit Youth Initiative and others. Their events are free and open to the public.
